

Campsite Terms and conditions and Frequently asked questions

We ask you to abide by the following requests to ensure everyone has an enjoyable and safe holiday.

- PLEASE POP IN TO THE OUTSIDE BAR IN THE MARQUEE TO PAY FOR CAMPING BEFORE SETTING UP.
- No pitches are reserved and are allocated on a first come first served basis.
- No fires of any description are permitted (BBQs, Firepits etc).
- No fireworks or Chinese lanterns.
- Music must be kept to a suitable volume so as not to disturb other guests,

STRICTLY NO MUSIC AFTER 9PM.

- All dogs must be kept on leads and please ensure you clean up after them.
- Strictly NO rubbish is to be disposed of on our grounds or in our bins please take all rubbish away with you. It is also strictly prohibited to leave any large items such as mattresses or camping equipment on our grounds.
- We will not be held responsible or liable for an accidents, loss or damage whatsoever to persons, vehicles, caravans/campers, motorhomes, accessories or contents during your stay.
- Please vacate your pitch by noon on your departure date.
- Any campers being a nuisance or ignoring these terms and conditions may be asked to leave the site.

FAOs

Can we camp in a tent?

Unfortunately due to changes in our insurance policy this year WE CAN NO LONGER ACCEPT GUESTS CAMPING IN TENTS.

Can we arrive on the day without booking?

We can not accept walk-ins, all camping visits must be pre-booked. Please email us your Camping Booking Form at info@yewtreechalvington.com.

What time can we arrive?

We ask that you check in and set up between 10am - 6pm. Please let us know at time of booking if you want to arrive later than 6pm.

What facilities have you got on site?

Our facilities are very basic consisting of two outdoor flushing toilets, which are open during the pub opening hours, and an outdoor tap providing running water. These facilities are found over at the pub.

Is there electricity at the campsite?

Unfortunately, we do not have any facilities to hook up to electricity.

Can we stay for just one night?

Yes, we have no minimum stay.

Can we bring our dog?

Both the campsite and the pub are dog friendly but we do ask that you keep your dog on the lead at all times and also clean up after them.

Can we bring a generator?

We do not allow you to bring generators due to the noise they create.
